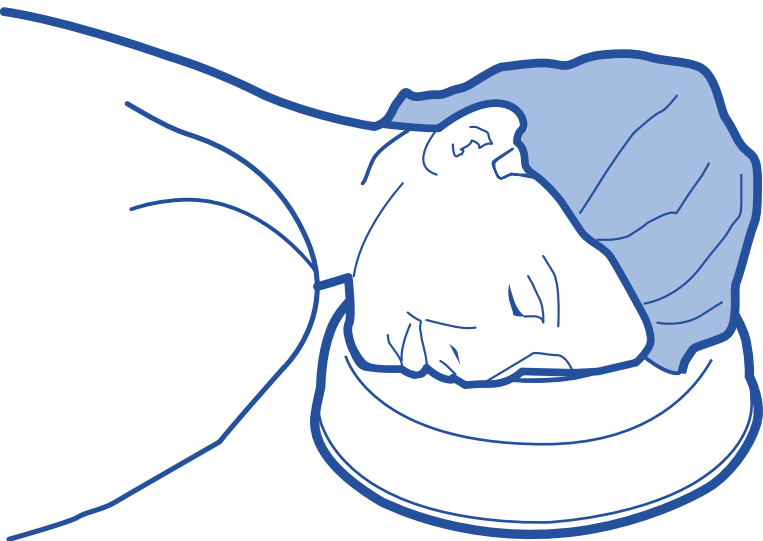

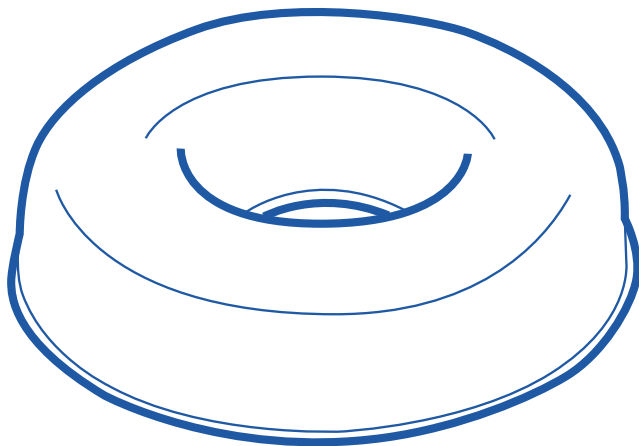

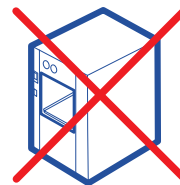

Description

- + Horseshoe-shaped head support made from polyurethane foam

Intended use

- + Supports patient's heads in the lateral position

Indications for Use

- + Reusable - clean using non-alcohol hospital wipes
- + Recommended for adults, but use will depend on patient's stature
- + Supports patient's head in the lateral position
- + Can be used for patients who are in the prone or lateral position
- + Reduces the incidence of pressure ulcers and marking
- + Patient can be repositioned without disconnecting their tubing, so PEEP pressure is maintained
- + Latex and phthalate free
- + Instructions for use are packaged with the product

Warnings, Precautions, Contraindications & Adverse Effects

- + Incorrect positioning of the patient on this product can cause:
 - + Pressure marking or ulcers
 - + Neurological damage, which can cause paraplegia
 - + Venous pressure, which can lead to ischaemia
- + Do not immerse in water
- + Do not autoclave
- + Do not use if this product is torn or damaged

Packaging

- + Each Unit is packaged in a recyclable polyethylene bag
- + 1 unit is packaged into a cardboard box for sale

Transport & Storage

- + Transport and store in dry conditions and out of direct light where possible
- + Avoid storing where sharp objects could pierce the skin of the product
